Step Back in Time at El Rancho de las Golondrinas!

There's no better place for a New Mexico wine festival than this old Spanish ranch named El Rancho de las Golondrinas (Ranch of the Swallows). It was founded 300 years ago in 1710 and was an historic *paraje*, or stopping place, on El Camino Real, the Royal Road to Mexico City. The ranch was an oasis of water and tall grass, a one-day journey to Santa Fe. Visit 34 historic buildings and see costumed villagers baking in beehive ovens (*hornos*), carding, spinning and weaving wool, blacksmithing and grinding grain. Visit the Museum Shop for one-of-a-kind crafts, special gifts and southwest books.

Did you know that New Mexico is the country's oldest wine-making state? Meet the vintners and sample the delicious reds, whites and sparkling blends from seventeen New Mexico wineries! You can purchase wine by the glass, bottle or case.
